 On 3rd July, 2021, a survey was conducted by the Secretary, Mrs. Poonam Srivastava, founder member Mr. Madhav Shrivastava, and, activist Mr. Ajay Yadav in the slums of Sethi Nagar and Sainik Society and fifteen houses were identified, the roof of which were in a dilapidated condition and the income of residing families had stopped due to the



spread of COVID-19. Gauging the possibility of their household belongings getting damaged due to rains, NGO realized the need to provide tarpaulin to these families immediately. After discussion with the office bearers of the NGO, Tarpaulin was provided to families before the onset of the monsoons.

 Secretary, Mrs. Poonam Shrivastava, Vice President, Adv. Arvind Srivastava, activist, Mr. Ajay Yadav and witness Mr. Govind Shrivastava, visited the Pioneer MP Online Kiosk to apply online for the registration of the NGO under the name *"Nirmal Sehyog Sansthan"*.



3. NGO identified two students, Pawan Yadav and Akash Yadav, who needed assistance in continuing their education. Their family was contacted for verification, and it was confirmed that their father passed away in January, 2021 while their mother had lost her job due to the lockdown imposed during COVID-19. NGO reached out to its members and their network in the stationery trading sector for donations in the form of books, copies and other commodities to support Pawan's and Akash's education. Founder member Jhuma Bose provided the books while the copies were arranged through donations received by the NGO. President, Dr. Savita Verma, Secretary, Mrs. Poonam Shrivastava along with activist Mr. Ajay Yadav visited Government Higher Secondary School in Rampur, Chitransh Higher Secondary School in Ramnagar, Balak Mandir Higher Secondary School in MPEB, and, Adarsh Shishu Mandir Higher Secondary School in Polypathar to meet their Principals and brief them about the NGO's intention to support the education of students who lost their parents or an earning members of the household due to COVID-19.

The concerned schools' management were then



requested to inform the NGO whenever they identify any such student requiring support.

- A meeting of the office bearers and functionaries of the Institution was held on 10.07.2021 at the residence of Mrs. Poonam Srivastava, Secretary, Nirmal Sehyog. The details of the meeting were as follows:
 - Membership fees and donations received by the NGO members was deposited with the Treasurer and entered in the register.
 - Treasurer, Ms. Kusum Kanta and founder member, Mr. Madhav Shrivastava jointly presented the details of donations received till date and the expenditure incurred on the activities of the NGO.
 - Details of the activities of the NGO till date were discussed and analysed. It was realized that the motivation and mobilization of the beneficiaries from the townships visited by the NGO had been the main factor in the success of applications for ration cards.
 - Vice President, Adv. Arvind Shrivastava outlined a plan of action to expand the membership of NGO and improve donations and laid guidelines for conducting NGO activities.
 - Vice President, Adv. Arvind Shrivastava stepped forward to take the responsibility of the NGO's registration which involved preparing

documentation and submitting it in the concerned office.
